From tomorrow, the following will be put in place.

1. To avoid the congestion and improve social distancing in the small playground in the morning during drop off, once you have dropped off pupils with Mrs Conlin, if you have older siblings in Class Griffin or Class Phoenix rather than waiting for 8.45 please drop your child off at the Breakfast club using the side door to the hall. Please tell Lisa or Debbie that you have dropped them off and do not need a breakfast.
2. All children arriving by bus will be taken straight to the Breakfast club.
3. For parents who are walking to school with their children please can they enter the school site by the brown wooden gates and then follow the one-way system around school. Please do not enter or exit the playground on foot through the double metal gates as this is for vehicles only and we do not want any accidents.
4. Any child who is going to be late or has to leave school for a medical/dental appointment please could parents come to the main door and wait there to drop off or collect their child. We are asking that parents **do not** enter the school unless a prior appointment has been made.
5. PE days are:  
Class Unicorn and Class Griffin – **Friday**.  
Class Phoenix – **Monday**.

On these days, can **all** pupils come to school in their PE Kits? This is to reduce the risk of cross contamination when changing clothes and to reduce staff contact with fastening laces and assisting
